Queen of the Desert, Masterful Spy & Diplomat

Gertrude Bell lived an extraordinary life. Chiefly remembered for her pioneering assimilation of Arabic culture, she was also a brilliant scholar, archaeologist, mountaineer and linguist.

Beautiful red hair, fine features and piercing green eyes, Bell was the first woman to get a degree in modern history at Oxford; first woman ever to travel the Syrian desert alone, and the first female officer in British Military Intelligence. Fluent in Arabic and Persian, she spent a decade before World War I crisscrossing the desert, making maps and gaining the trust of tribal leaders and kings. She knew the Mesopotamian region and its people so intimately that one prominent Iraqi sheik, when asked about geographical boundaries of his tribe, told his questioner to ask Bell.

She virtually created modern Iraq, drafted its borders, corralled its reluctant tribal chiefs and trained Faisal (who had never been there) to be its first king.
